Curt Kasper retires from Dakotas Chapter NECA

After 10 plus years—and more than 230,000 highway miles with the Dakotas Chapter NECA, Curt Kasper is retiring on August 28th, 2025. Originally hired in late March of 2015 as the Assistant Executive Director, Kasper's duties slowly evolved into a second title of Manager of Career Development.

"Typically, a NECA Chapter hires an Executive Assistant to be groomed to be the next leader of the Chapter," Kasper said. "But back in 2015, Ed had the foresight to do something no other NECA Chapter had done—he hired a career development position to recruit electrical workers. The Board agreed with his decision, I got the job, and it's been an interesting ride for more than ten years," he said.

As time went on, Kasper learned more and more about NECA—and specifically about the members of the Dakotas Chapter—"it became apparent that this was a special organization made up of very special people," he said.

In a short speech presented during the summer membership meeting, Kasper thanked the Chapter affiliates and partners for helping him along in many different ways. He thanked all the contractor members for putting up with him and supporting him.

"Thanks to our Board for your support and having the confidence in me to let me do my job. At my first Board meeting they asked me to tell them a little bit about myself. The first thing I said was, 'you know, Ed and I are not the same person . . . I think they were relieved,'" he said.

He also thanked his family and colleagues saying, "Each one of you contributed and supported my journey in a special way. I owe each of you a hundred favors, except for Darla, I probably owe you a thousand favors."

And when addressing Ed he said, "You're one of the smartest people I know. You have taught me, coached me and guided me on this journey. Thanks for the fun, and thanks for giving me this wonderful opportunity."

Kasper doesn't have any immediate plans for retirement. "We'll just wait and see what opportunities pop up," he said.
